




# INSTALLATION A CAUTION

- To prevent burns, allow the engine, exhaust system, radiator, etc., to cool before installing the accessory.
- 1. Remove the seat as shown.




- 2. Set the seat bag strap as shown.
  - Repeat on the right side.


### <Left side>




3. Pass the protection belt as shown.




Install the assembled seat bag strap as shown.
 Rear side>




5. Install the assembled seat bag strap as shown.




- 6. Install the seat in the reverse order of removal.
- 7. Install the rear seat bag as shown.




- 8. Tighten the straps while adjusting the balance between the right and left sides of the rear seat bag as shown.
  - Repeat on the right side.
  - Secure well by pulling the straps tight.






9. Wind the strap as shown.



10. Secure the strap end as shown.



- 11. Secure the other straps in the same manner.
- 12. Make sure that the rear seat bag does not protrude to the rear of the rear cowl as shown.
  - If the rear seat bag protrudes, adjust the tensions of front and rear seat bag strap.
